

Open Programming Competition 2018



Time, Place, and Registration

The competition is open to all UMSL students as of the SP2018 semester. It will take place **May 11 2018, in the ESH building, between 1pm and 4pm**. Winners will be announced in a single competition, those who first solve all problems or who solve the most problems, sharing up to \$1500 in prizes.

No registration is required, but pre-registration will secure you a spot—unregistered people will be welcome as space permits. The competition will take place on ESH 3rd floor and will overflow to one of the 1st floor rooms if needed.

Please come in early, lunch will be provided.

Competition Statement

The competition will involve individuals programming about 6 problems, in the language of your choice from C, C++, or Java, and on a platform of your choice, but there will be automated testing on Delmar, see the Details page for more information. You may bring your own computer or use a UMSL computer in a provided computer lab or classroom. The competition will take up to 3 hours. Most problems can be solved with knowledge gained starting in Cmp Sci 1250 and 2250.
