

Tenure-Track Assistant Professor Position in Computer Science at the University of Missouri-St. Louis

The Department of Mathematics and Computer Science at the University of Missouri-St. Louis (UMSL) invites applications for a full-time, tenure-track faculty position at the rank of Assistant Professor in Computer Science, beginning Fall 2014. Qualified candidates are expected to have a Ph.D. in Computer Science or closely related discipline. Salary is competitive and dependent upon qualifications.

The department is seeking applicants with proven ability to conduct outstanding research and strong commitment to teaching at both undergraduate and graduate levels. Qualified candidates in all areas of Computer Science will be considered, with preferences given to information security, mobile computing, and big data.

At the present time, the department has 25 full-time faculty members and 9 graduate teaching assistants. The department offers Bachelor's and Master's degrees in Mathematics and Computer Science and Ph.D. in Applied Mathematics with an option in Computer Science.

Candidates must prepare a letter of application, current vita, a statement of research and teaching philosophy (this material to be submitted as a single pdf file), and three letters of reference. All of these items must be electronically submitted to cssearch@umsl.edu. Additional questions may also be directed to the same email address.
